

Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 9.1 tCO₂e by 2028. This is a reduction of 19%.

Carbon Reduction Projects

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the 2023 baseline. The carbon emission reduction achieved by these schemes will be reported beginning with our 2024 Emissions Reporting. These measures will remain in effect when performing the contract.

- Towards the end of 2023, Corcym stopped using the services of a third-party warehouse facility, opting to reduce overall costs and additional transportation drops within the UK.
- The UK sales team are encouraged to use Microsoft Teams whenever possible for meetings rather than face to face meetings.
- Corcym UK (Holdings) Ltd uses a train the trainer approach for proctoring their customers. This involves a single proctoring visiting another hospital to train other surgeons. With the introduction of new advanced technology, we aim to move these proctoring sessions to virtual proctoring session whenever possible, thus reducing the necessity for travel.
- Data storage domain retirements have taken place, local storage has moved to the cloud (OneDrive).
- Moving to digital has reduced home printers from 6 to 4.
- Monthly business review meetings have been moved to Microsoft Team meetings
- Our use of paper has been reduced through the utilization of DocuSign and online document lifecycle management systems.

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

- Educational sessions will be delivered to support awareness of how employees can reduce their electricity consumption to support energy efficiency improvements.
- Employees are encouraged to move away from diesel cars and towards electric vehicles.
- The Global Travel policy will be updated to govern the type of meetings that are permitted face to face. Where travel is unavoidable, e.g. video conferencing or other

technology does not meet needs, employees will be expected to consolidate appointments to minimise travel.

• Actively incentivise low emission travel and socialise the above policy.

Declaration and Sign Off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.
